

I used google maps and there was probably 30+ shown. In my opinion the book is not worth the money. In the book there usually are not more than 2-3 B&Bs listed per city which makes it difficult to shop for the best deals.

First of all, I wish there were more photos of the B&Bs. Second, I was expecting more B&Bs in the towns and cities, for instance, there was only one B&B in Cork. Finally, I hope the rates haven't gone up too much since 2008.
