

"Striking a Balance: A comprehensive Approach to Early Literacy" is very "comprehensive" indeed. It is a thick book of 457 pages and so it requires a good amount of time to read through, take notes and digest. The textbook gives in-depth details to help children read. The book covers theories on reading acquisition. You will also find systems covered such as the: grapho-phonological, syntactic, semantic, pragmatic systems and more. The textbook covers how students may acquire sight vocabulary and looks at how a teacher can use a holistic approach. Teachers will be advised as to how to use drama and theater to help develop fluency. Assessment data is included. Be prepared to read, study and digest! The book is thick and heavy to carry around but helpful. One may be able to find it online?
