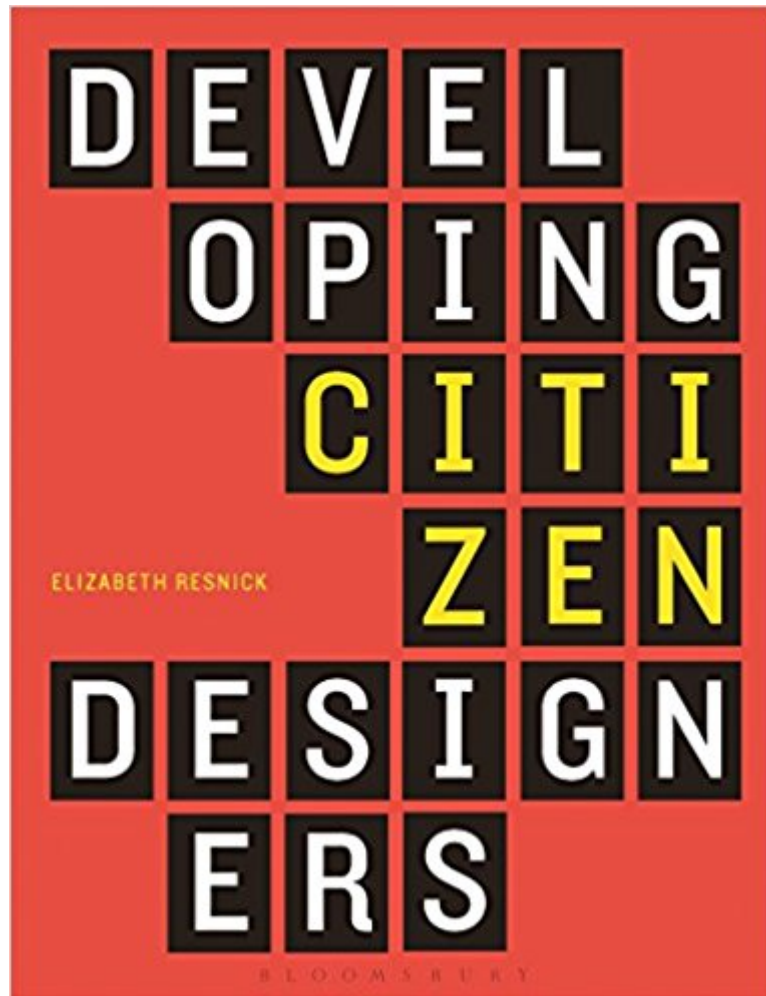

The aim of this book is to enable students, educators and designers in the early stages of their careers to learn and practise design in a socially responsible manner.
