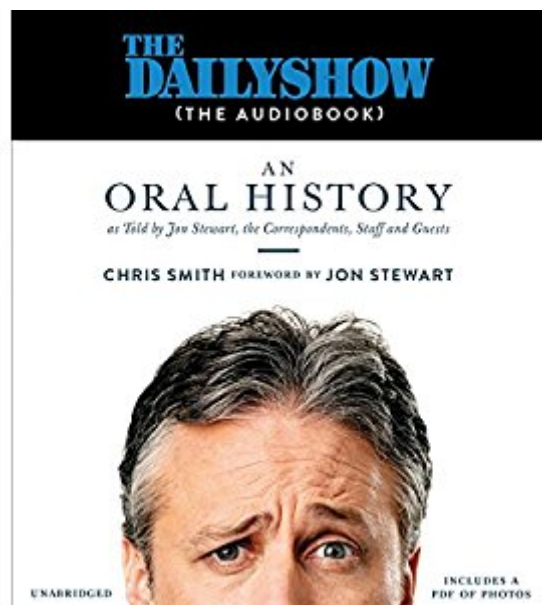

Pulls back the covers to describe the thought processes (and interpersonal conflicts) related to the cultural phenomena that was The Daily Show with John Stewart. There's plenty of dirty laundry that's aired, so it certainly doesn't seem like a puff-piece. I still get angry reading some of the stories, how they showed what seems to be a genuinely authentic man and his attempts to expose

the sartorial coverage of deep issues by all sides of the political spectrum.

As succinctly as I can put it - Jon Stewart and the daily show made me less apathetic, less a cynic, and helped me go from cynical teen to informed adult. I know Stewart would cringe to hear this, but he was, for my formative years, the most straightforward voice in news - he and the cast of amazing correspondents over the years helped teach me and so many others thru humor about the value of paying attention to politics and the world at large around us all. Is the book a flawless telling of history? No, of course not. But it's exactly what you want from a history of the show- it's funny, snarky, self deprecating, and has so much heart and goodwill. Deep, deep, deep in the snark pits, but it's there. In short- if you've ever liked the daily show, get this book.
