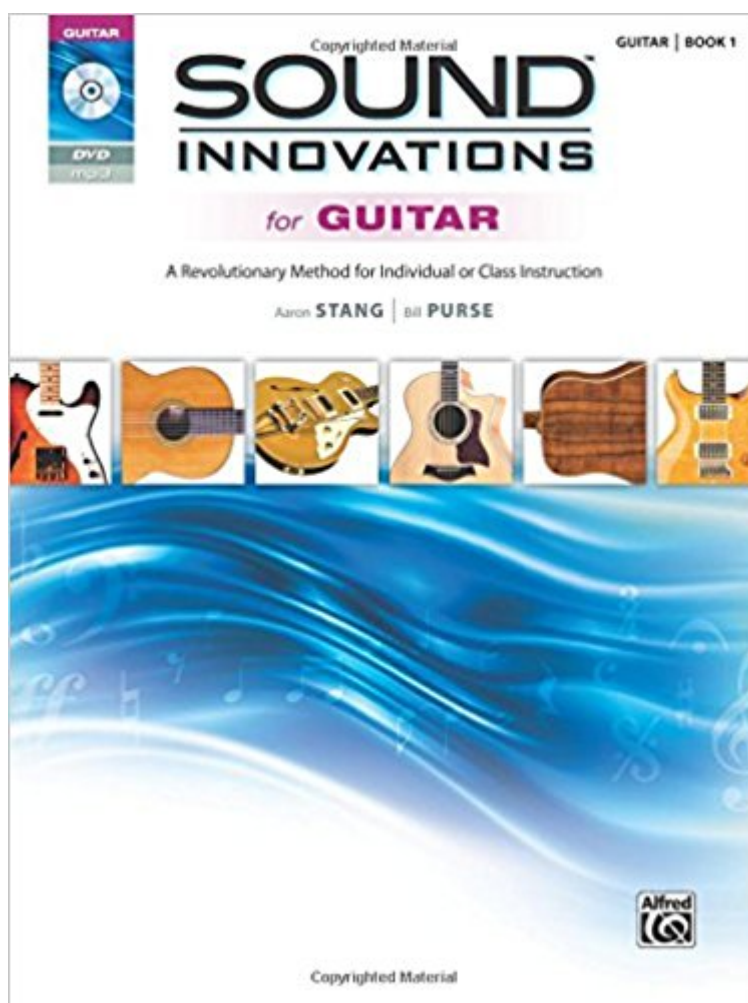

Aaron Stang has written two great guitar methods and each has a different purpose and focus. The first, entitled simply Guitar Method is great for really focusing on learning to read standard notation on the guitar and it has lots of great songs for accomplishing this purpose. It also has a theory workbook available that works in tandem with the Method. The second, written with Bill Purse, and entitled Sound Innovations for Guitar, has a much broader scope than the Guitar Method. In addition to learning to teaching standard notation it includes instruction in fingerpicking, blues lead guitar, playing by ear, three chord rock, and some nice classical pieces. For the student who wants to focus on learning to read standard notation I would pick the Guitar Method. For the student who wants to broaden their horizons on the guitar, Sound Innovations would be the logical pick.
