

Remember how David slew Goliath, Daniel faced those lions, Paul survived a shipwreck, and Jesus stood up for a woman about to be killed? God made boys to take His truth and do something with it, to man up and change the world. Think of this book as your action plan for just that. These devotions will challenge you to live a bold, action-packed life for God. Every day you'll read a little Scripture and a short truth about being God's man. But then you'll be dared to put it into action. You'll roll up your sleeves and take on dares like drawing a comic strip, collecting school supplies for needy kids, or creating your own movie. Are you up for the challenge? We triple dog dare you!

I'm on the fence. It's not bad, but it's not the best one we've done either. I can imagine it's tough to

write a devo book to appeal to boys of all levels. I will say my son likes it, but I have to really unpack/elaborate things to make it meaningful. Maybe that's what this book is supposed to do, or what us dad's are supposed to do....right? This book can serve as inspiration to get you talking to your son about following Jesus and the practical ways we do that. Topically it works.....it's not too long.....so yeah, it does work. 4 stars is appropriate with that in mind. At the end of the day it's your responsibility as a follower of Jesus leading your son, so tools like this help get you started.

My son was very excited to get this book. Previously, I was reading him bible stories and explaining them to him. This book is great as a beginner devotional. He's now in the habit of opening his study bible, looking up the verse and then reading the message in his Triple Dog Dare. Now I ask him if he's "done his triple dog" and he will then go on to explain what he just learned to me. You solidify what you learn by explaining what you learned to someone else. This is a perfect beginner devotional for a 10 year old boy. I do recommend parental guidance though, just to keep them on track.

My 10 year old nephew LOVES this book. He just got it for christmas and now looks forward to reading his Bible every day! We looked it over prior to giving it to him and were pleased to see that it is a straight forward, no-nonsense kind of book that speaks right to the matters that a kid that age might deal with; puberty, emotions, fighting, doubt, etc We will buy one of these when our son gets to that age!

My boys are 9 and 6, I have been able to use this devotional and it has worked great. The only reason I have suggested the older ages is a couple of areas that may be more directed to older boys. Of course this is my perception, and we keep a tight lid on the information that is fed to our kids. You know, the computer is in the kitchen where we are always walking by, and do not watch many movies simply because another kid at school saw it. I believe the heart of a child is like a garden and we should weed out the garbage before it takes root. Doing this requires some sifting of the debris in our culture to protect them.

I've just started this with my 10 year old son. It is easy to read and keeps him interested. It's good for character building, thinking about how to live out our faith while still being "cool" for an elementary school aged kid. It is also a good way to connect with him and start good conversations. This book is really designed to read each day in the morning and then try to complete the "dares"

that day but we read at night so we try to do the dares the next day. His allowance is partially based on him completing the dares and this keeps him motivated to remember and try to do them.

I have a 10 year old and a 12 year old, both boys. They seem to be enjoying these much more than past devotions they had done. This really gets them engaged and makes them think. The dares are great, as they can live out the gospel throughout their daily lives. It's easy for them to comprehend and has helped them to be a bit nicer to each other as well.

This was bought for my 11 year old son. We usually read in the evenings before he goes to bed. It's been an enjoying time for him to have that extra alone time while his siblings are in bed.

This is a decent dovtional. My 9 year old likes it so far. It did encourage him to invite his school friends to church so that was great. I don't feel like it's an amazing devotional but it's certainly not bad either.
