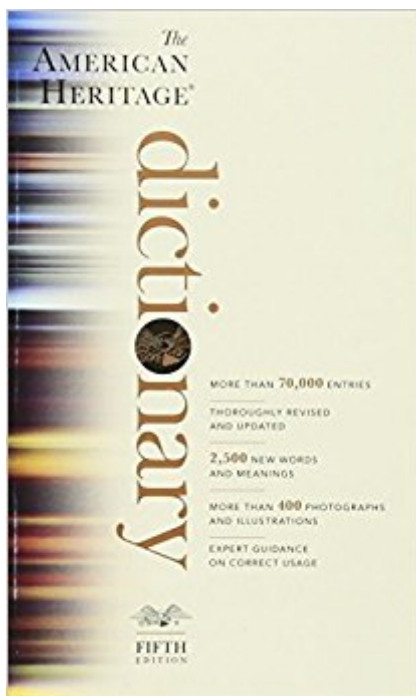


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A review by Don the Baptist of *The American Heritage Dictionary*.
