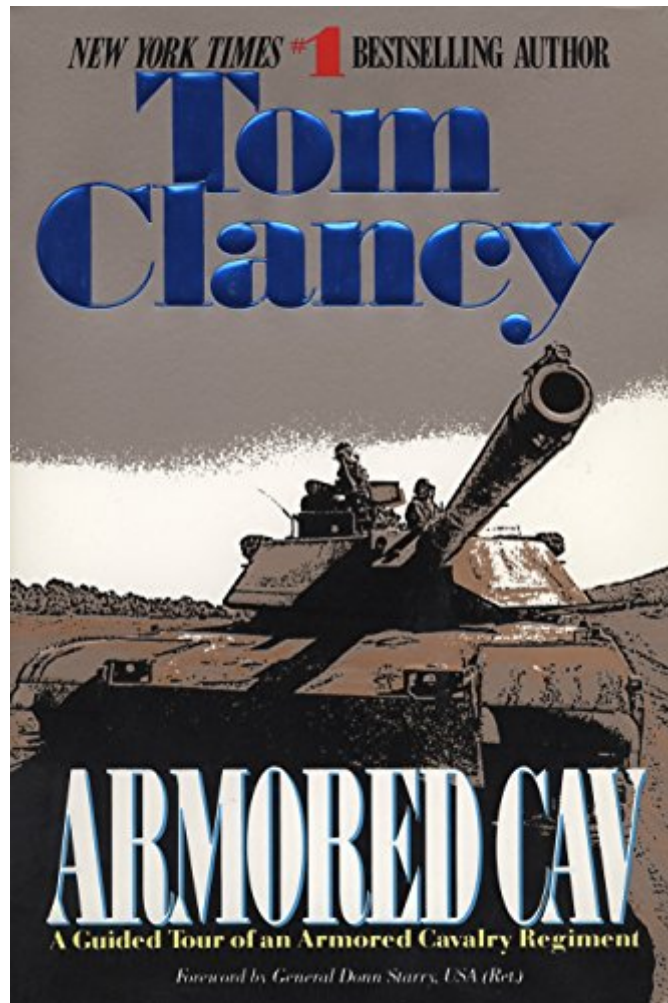




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Armored Cav (Tom Clancy's Military Referenc)
