Lost Lands (Changing times Book 2) reeled me in from the beginning. Shaun Griffiths provides us

with an entertaining novel about the struggle between good and evil. Shifters who transform into snow bears and others from another clan who transform into cats and dogs combine forces to rescue a friend. Evil lurks and constantly threatens the clans. Beyond a forest that provides an impenetrable and invisible wall that protects the clans from danger is the one called "Him." He is a powerful evil force that controls and commands a clan of nasty apes. His goal is for the apes to destroy the shifters, leaving him in complete power. What he needs is a crystal: a powerful crystal that could provide the clans protection from his evil or could provide the evil enough power to rule the land.

Honestly, I never think the sequel is going to be a more exciting read than the first book, but this one shatters that notion. This book was so thoroughly enjoyable. I was happy to see that Vin and Naz were front and center in this book. They are the shape shifting bears, and are truly my favorite characters. They are honest and hardworking guards with an affable manner and an unshakable good nature. And they are funny! I understood a lot more about the crystal in this book as the author goes more into depth about this mysterious gem and gives us some interesting backstory about it, and the three powerful books that go with it. I would love to see even more about the origins of the gem. The author further develops the already established characters of Holly, Carter, Kerri, Salli and Lulu in particular, along with many others. This book can be a stand-alone which I really appreciate because it does give some closure to the story, or you can continue reading the next book to see what happens with the crystal. Great read!

I devoured the book *Lost Lands* (Changing Times Book 2) by Shaun L Griffiths in one day. Even though it was book two, and I hadn't read book one, I had no trouble entering into the world of this intriguing saga. It has great pacing and characterization. Written by Shaun L. Griffiths, the Lost Lands is one of the best books anyone could ask for. If you like a heartfelt and action packed story in an intriguing world filled with the most wondrous characters, then this is it. This may be the second book in the series, but that didn't stop me from enjoying it even though I've not read a single page of book 1.
