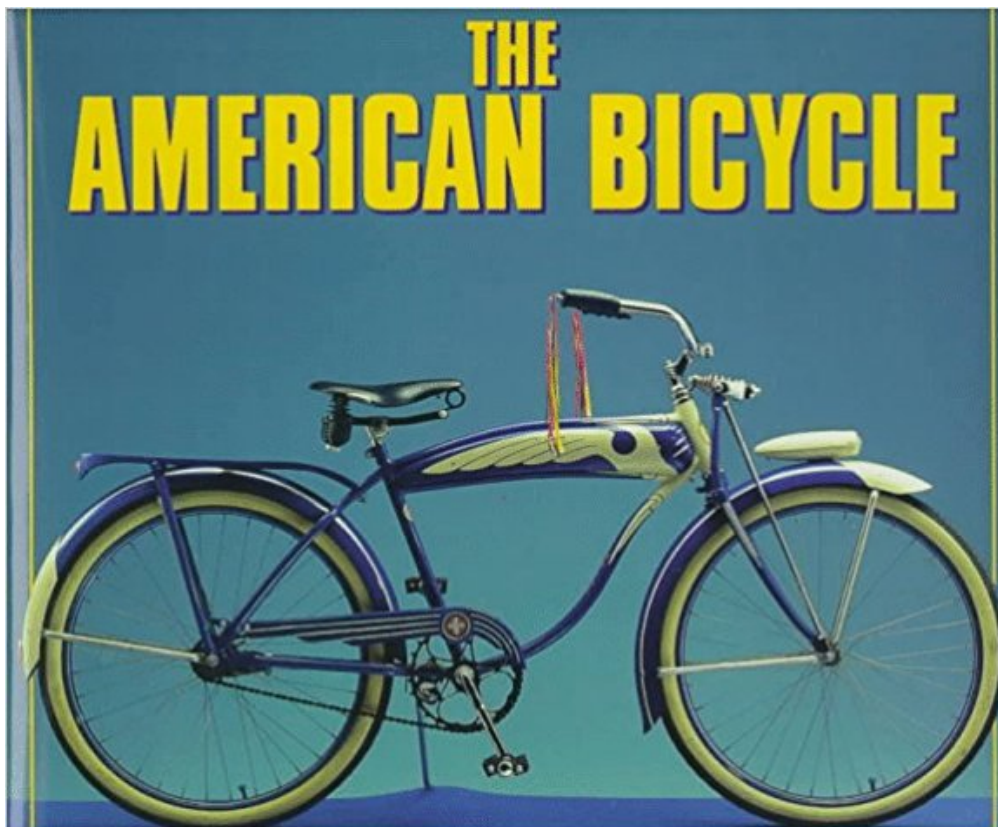

This book is awesome, alone for the really outstanding quality of the pictures, but also for the history information, never mind some minor typos in the text now and then. It shows American bicycles "of all ages" from 1870 to 1994, but particularly the enthusiast or collector for 1930s to 1950s American cruisers (like me) will LOVE it; although picturing the bicycles from several angles in order to capture more details would have been desirable... but understandingly, it also would have gone beyond the scope and practical size of this book.
