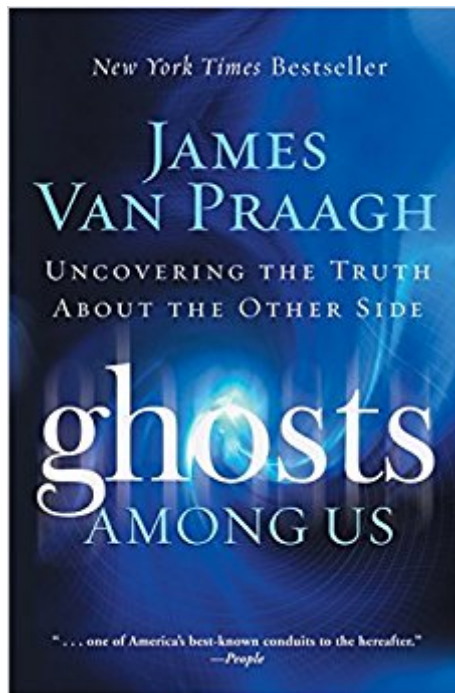




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Ghosts Among Us: Uncovering The Truth About The Other Side

I also feel that the spirit of the deceased person comes back to say goodbye. That is something I learned from a Navajo woman and I have felt that in many instances. But I cannot wrap my head around the idea of choosing ahead of time what kind of life you will have because you need to learn something more on your journey. I doubt the three women in Ohio, just released after 10 years, decided that they wanted to live that life away from loved ones and being beaten and tortured. I also do not think that if you are feeling low or unhappy that you are opening yourself up to the "mean" spirits. I think everyone has a bad day now and then and they are entitled to it. I read it with a very open mind but the more it went on the more I could not wait to finish it.

This book changed my life forever. Immediately after reading I purchased several copies for friends and clients but never took the time to write a review. I actually stumbled across it again when I saw James Van Praagh listed as a guest speaker on Davidji's Hay House radio broadcast. Since I was a child I have had a strong connection to the spirit world. Some of my experiences were very dark and misunderstood they had me constantly on guard and many times afraid. After reading *Ghosts Among Us* I have a much better understanding of the spirit world and can say in the 2 1/2 years since reading it I haven't had a single negative experience with "ghosts". But I had no idea, at the time of reading this book, that one of the spirits among me would be the man I was so deeply in love with. My better understanding of the spirit world (because of this book) is how I have been able to deal with his suicide. I have a much better understanding of his strong presence. On the day they
