

For a short time I was disappointed that Roland Merullo veered from the path of his three road trip books with Otto Ringling and Volya Rinpoche. Within several paragraphs I realized this new road trip book would be equally captivating, as indeed it was. I stayed up half the night to finish reading

it. As with the previous books, this one is spiced with frequent laser-sharp observations and adages that may keep me journaling for months. If you've read the meals with Buddha series, you must read this new book. It's a sidebar story that does look back in. If you haven't read the previous three, this volume is as good a place to start as any. Now I'm holding breath, waiting for Merullo to return to the Rinpoche stream.

Good but not great read. Mildly amusing. Mildly thought provoking. Mildly sacriligeous. But a little preachy in places. A little like a hallmark card or Kincaid painting.

I loved this ALMOST as much as Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner with Buddha.

An extremely fun and thought-provoking novel. Delightful for certain. Merullo gives his readers a lot to think about. His books are all deeply spiritual without being pedantic or dogmatic.
