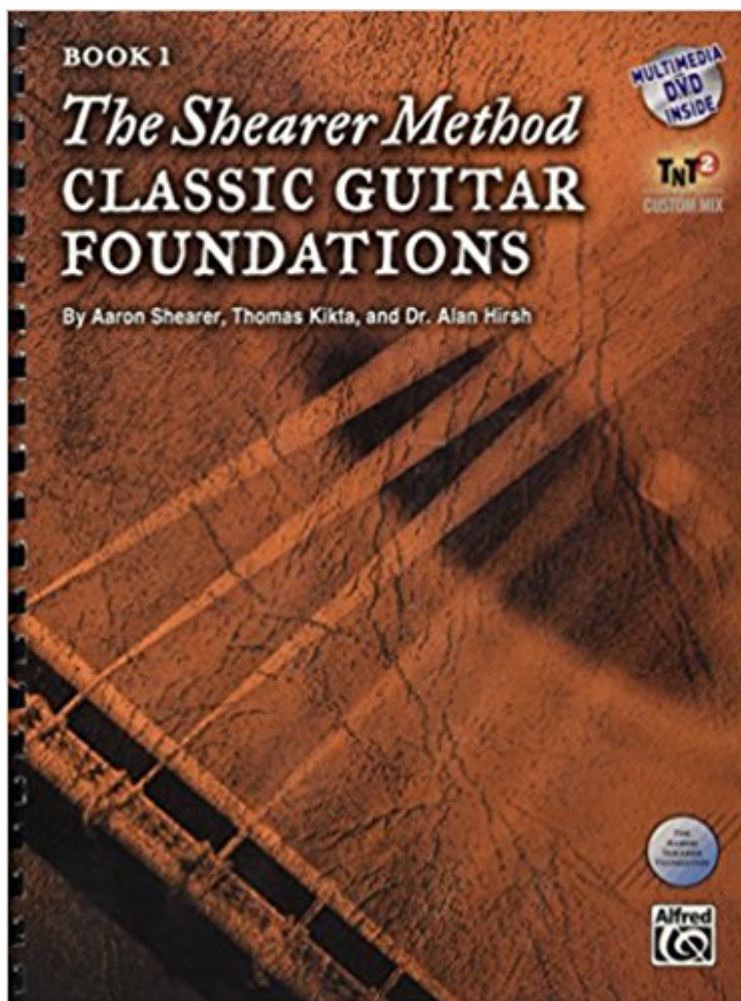

I am a professional music educator who teaches classroom guitar. I have used several other guitar

method books in the classroom setting and in private lessons, but this is by far my favorite for ages 13 and up. It is comprehensive, well-paced, and engaging. In my experience, no other method comes close to the Shearer Method in terms of pedagogy and technique. I appreciate that this method only uses standard music notation, not tablature. A versatile guitarist should be able to read standard notation. (Tablature is quick and easy to learn on the students' own time, no book necessary.) The music presented in this book is substantial and worthwhile. It was amazing to see the improvements in my students when I started using this method. From a music educator's standpoint, this book is highly recommended for students ranging from 8th grade to adults.

This is book 1 of the latest Shearer guitar method. Over the years, my guitar students have struggled with the right hand. This book is the answer. It starts out using the thumb and then adds "i, m & a." I think it is a bit redundant and spends too much time on boring exercises. However, as with most subjects, the teacher needs to differentiate for each student, and this is a nice tool.

This is an excellent, methodical text. The slow pace (if observed) permits students to gain confidence with each technique before adding new challenges. The pace and organization encourage the establishment of good, right-hand posture and foster confident performance experiences. Dynamics and phrasing are introduced from the earliest exercises. New concepts are carefully chosen and ordered. This is a great example of well-planned pedagogy and I have found it to be especially useful for students to whom classical guitar is a completely new style (eg. first year college non-majors, hobbyists, class guitar).

I have tried several other method books. This book along with my guitar teacher has helped me make more progress in the last three months than I had in the prior three years. Excellent organization and really fun to use!

Excellent take on Shearer's early work, more progressive and gradual than previous books.

This is a good beginning book, with a good set of pieces and nice explanations of position for playing, finger issues, and all the basic techniques.

I am so glad for this resource. I am brand new to classical guitar and to guitar playing in general and I find that the Shearer method lays a good foundation with the right goals.

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
